### Bundaberg, Gympie, Hervey Bay and Maryborough campuses

The Certificates in Spoken and Written English are predominantly for people who speak a language other than English. They are an individualised educational program for those people who want to improve their listening, speaking, reading and writing English skills. They provide a learning pathway for people who want to continue studying but do not have the necessary English language skills. The purpose of these programs is to assist adult learners of non-English speaking backgrounds to develop the language and literacy skills required to undertake further education and training, seek and maintain employment, and participate in the community.

**Careers:** Improved spoken and written English will enhance your employment prospects.

## General English Language Program (ESL) (CNQ27)

**Delivery Mode:** On campus

### Bundaberg, Gympie, Hervey Bay and Maryborough campuses

This is a full fee paying English program for some people on temporary visas who are not on student visas and who do not qualify for government-assisted programs such as the Adult English Migrant Program (AMEP). The lessons will be delivered in a supportive and fun environment, with class sizes kept to a maximum of 18 to ensure a personalised approach. The program will provide the skills to make working and participating in the local Australian community easier. At an advanced level, it can help in preparing for the International English Language Testing Program (IELTS) test which is a requirement for some people working in Australia.

**Careers:** Be able to participate in and be a part of the local community, gain confidence in using the language, become more self reliant in everyday situations, and be prepared for the IELTS test.

## Certificate II in Access 10 (Year 10 Equivalent) (80737ACT)

**Delivery Mode:** On campus, off campus

### Bundaberg, Gympie, Hervey Bay and Maryborough campuses

Looking for an alternative to Year 10? This program provides an equivalent level of study to a school year 10 within an adult education setting. It aims to develop literacy and numeracy skills to a recognised level of education, and facilitate opportunities for further study including vocational education and training.

**Careers:** Defence forces entrance exam, further education and training.

## Certificate IV in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) (40540SA)

Delivery Mode: On campus

### Hervey Bay campus

This program offers basic training in teaching English to speakers of other languages. You will be given a brief introduction to techniques of classroom management and assessment, and a more thorough introduction to presentation techniques, lesson preparation and analysing language for communicative purposes. This program is highly practical and a major emphasis will be practice teaching.
