Program Description

Persons accredited under the Traffic Controller Accreditation Scheme are authorised by Queensland Transport to control traffic at road worksites where a road closure is necessary, and other events where a road closure or part road closure is necessary.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Traffic Controllers must have held an Australian or foreign provisional or open drivers licence for a continuous period of 12 months within the last 5 years.

A person must meet the strict entry requirements to become a traffic controller. Accreditation is for a period of three years, and traffic controllers must comply with the statutory conditions for appointment which are outlined in the persons instrument of appointment.
