



Generic Induction (GIQ) Coal Surface Passport – Heavy Industry Trades Program

Program Description	GIQ Coal is a new General Induction (GI) course for anyone working in Queensland in the coal mining industry. The development of GIQ Coal is in response to the introduction of Standard 11, the new Standard for meeting health and safety obligations in the coal mining industry in Queensland. This safety induction course for the coal mining industry workplaces is designed to provide resource industry workers with core risk and safety skills before undertaking a site-specific induction. Participants will need to complete the 6 core recognised competencies identified by Mining Industry Skills Centre to obtain a GIQ Coal Passport – Standard 11.
Entry Conditions	<p>This course is primarily designed for short-term contractors who move between multiple sites and have current industry experience relevant to their role.</p> <p>It is recommended that you have previous hands-on experience, exposure, and/or a trade qualification in mining or another heavy industry; or be a machine or plant operator (eg dozer, excavator, roller, scraper, back hoe, truck driver, tipper driver, loader).</p> <p>All participants must produce photo identification to the trainer on first day of class as proof of identity (eg driver's licence).</p>
Career Opportunities	On successful completion, coal mine workers will be able to move between sites and have a large portion of their site-specific induction training recognised without compromising the site's legislative requirements.
